#### Poetry

with a maximum of 50 lines.

#### Prose

Stories may have any theme,  
with a maximum of 4000 words.

will be judged by

**Nancy Gaffield**

Author of *Tokaido Road* (CB Editions, 2011)  
- shortlisted for the Forward  
and Aldeburgh first collection prizes.

There is no limit to the number of entries per person. The deadline for all entries is December 31<sup>st</sup> 2011. Entries with a post mark of December 31<sup>st</sup> will be accepted.

No entries must have been entered in any previous Save As competition or been placed in the top three in any other competition. Otherwise, previously published entries are accepted. The copyright of each entry remains with the writer but Save As Writers reserves the right to publish winning entries on its website.

The judge will see EACH poem – there is no sifting beforehand.
